### ORDER

In terms of Section 15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Dakshin Bharath Hindi Prachar Sabha, Chennai, Tamilnadu had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of permission to DBHPS Lal Bahadur Shastri College of Education, 113/114, S.C.Road, Sheshadripuram, Bangalore-560020, Karnataka for increasing the intake by 40 for B.Ed Course of one year duration from the academic session 2004-05.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:

- a. The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
- b. The institution has constructed the building for conducting the course on the above mentioned land.
- c. The institution has selected the Principal and Seven teachers for the said course and the list of faculty members has been approved by the Registrar of affiliating University.

3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby grants permission to DBHPS Lal Bahadur Shastri College of Education, 113/114, S.C.Road, Sheshadripuram, Bangalore-560020, Karnataka for B.Ed course of one year duration i.e. the academic session 2004-2005 with an annual intake of 100 students which includes the existing intake of 60 and an additional intake of 40 subject to fulfillment of the following.

- a. The institution will ensure that Principal and Seven faculty members duly approved by affiliating University are in position for an intake of 100 students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Southern Regional Committee immediately and in any case not later than one month from the date of commencement of the course.

## ORDER

In exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the National Council For Teacher Education (NCTE) Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee grants recognition to **Dakshin Bharat Hindi Prachar Sabha Lal Bahadur Shastri College of Education, 113/114, S.C.Road, Sheshadripuram, Bangalore-560020, Karnataka** for B.Ed Course of One year duration from the academic session 2000-2001 with an annual intake of 60 students, subject to fulfilling the following conditions:

1. All such teachers already appointed who do not have qualifications as per NCTE norms shall acquire the qualifications as per the norms within a period of two years of this order.
2. The institution shall ensure library, laboratories and other instructional infrastructure as per the NCTE norms.
3. Technical Assistant should be appointed.
4. The admission to the approved course shall be given only to those candidates who are eligible as per the regulations governing the course and in the manner laid down by the affiliating University / State Government.
5. Tuition fee and other fees will be charged from the students as per the norms of the affiliating University / State Government till such time NCTE regulations in respect of fee structure come into force.
6. Curriculum transaction, including practical work / activities, should be organised as per the norms and standards for the course and the requirements of the affiliating University / examining body.
7. Teaching days including practice teaching should not be less than the number fixed in the NCTE norms for the course.
8. The institution, if unaided, shall maintain endowment and reserve fund as per NCTE norms.
9. The institution shall continue to fulfil the norms laid down under the regulations of the NCTE and submit to the Regional Committee the Annual Report and the Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year. The performance appraisal report should inter alia give the extent of compliance of the conditions indicated above.

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If Dakshin Bharat Hindi Prachar Sabha Lal Bahadur Shastri College of Education, 113/114, S.C.Road, Sheshadripuram, Bangalore-560020, Karnataka contravenes the provisions of the NCTE Act or the rules, regulations and orders made or issued thereunder or fails to fulfill the above conditions, the Regional Committee may withdraw this recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

In exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the National Council For Teacher Education(NCTE) Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee grants recognition to **Dakshin Bharat Hindi Prachar Sabha Lal Bahadur Shastri College of Education, 113/114, S.C.Road, Sheshadripuram, Bangalore-560020, Karnataka** to **Shiksha Snatak Course of One year duration** from the academic session **2000-2001** with an annual intake of **30 students**, subject to fulfilling the following conditions :

1. The institution shall ensure library, laboratories and other instructional infrastructure as per the State Govt. norms.
2. The admission to the approved course shall be given only to those candidates who are eligible as per the regulations governing the course and in the manner laid down by the State Government/Examining body.
3. Tuition fee and other fees will be charged from the students as per the norms of the State Government till such time NCTE regulations in respect of fee structure come into force.

5. Teaching days including practice teaching should not be less than the number fixed in the State Govt. norms for the Language Teacher Training Course.
6. The institution, if unaided, shall maintain endowment and reserve fund as per State Govt. norms.
7. The institution shall continue to fulfill the norms laid down under the regulations by the State Govt./Examining body and submit to the Regional Committee the Annual Report and the Performance Appraisal Report. The performance appraisal report should inter alia give the extent of the compliance of the conditions indicated above and should be submitted by 31<sup>st</sup> December 2000.

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The recognition now accorded is subject to review after the NCTE formulates and prescribes its own norms applicable to the Language Teacher Training Course.
